Use a Canva Template

We have created a Canva template that can be used with a QR code that can be linked to any of the Google Forms you have created. <u>Click here</u> to access the template, select "Use template for new design" and then simply update the text, colours and add your own QR code.

On Canva's home page use the search function to search for other templates that are close to the design you want. You can change photo's, update colours & fonts and make it your own. Any template, photo, graphic, image, font with this icon is not available to use for free. You can either select something that is free, pay a one-off fee for the use of the image for your design or upgrade to Canva Pro.

Create your own design

To start from scratch select "Create a design" and then choose the size of your page, default "Doc - Auto size" or select from one of the options provided

- Click on the box "Untitled design Doc" and overtype this with your document name
- Click the + and select "Design".
- Click on "Elements" (left hand menu) and select the "Shape" to provide the backdrop for your design (drag out the edges to make the shape as big / small as you like)
- Click inside the shape to bring the colour palette options onto the screen (to the left of the font option)
- Click on "Text" (left hand menu) and select the type of text you want to add. Clicking on your selection will add to your design. Double click in the text box to update the text, font size, colour etc

Canva File Management

Projects Folder is your file management system in Canva. You can create folders for different work areas.

Sharing / Printing your Canva design

Click on the share icon located at the top right when you are working on your design You can share and "collaborate" with others, present, share on social media or download to print. If you are downloading Canva will recommend the best file type for your design but you are able to select from other available options.
